Blue has considerable experience working with multiple Federal, State and Local government agencies. Saturday, April 30. The voting concluded on Tuesday, May 3, where all votes were cast at the Judicial Annex building, located at 218 Parshley St. in Live Oak. Running in District 1 was sitting Councilman Robintina Reed, who received the most votes with 30 votes. Finishing second with 22 votes was Tommie Jefferson, followed by

## Deported felon attempts burglary

On Saturday, May 7, Suwannee County Sheriff's Deputies Shawn Steel and Derek Hedgespeth responded to a call at a local business located at the

intersection of Highway 129 and Interstate 10, north of Live Oak. Officers were advised the call was about a disturbance. Upon arrival on scene, the two officers determined Gustava Miramontes Nunez, 34-years-old, from Mount Dora, Fla., had attempted to gain entry into a female's vehicle by force with the intent to cause harm. When a male store employee saw what was taking place, he tried to intervene. At this time, Nunez chased him around the parking lot and threatened to kill him.

Deputies Steel and Hedgespeth then put Nunez under

On Friday, May 6, the Suwannee County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) received a call from an individual referring to himself as "Billy Arnold." Arnold reported that he saw a female being forced into a vehicle against her will. This made multiple SCSO deputies, as well as multiple Live Oak Police Department (LOPD) officers, begin to search for the car. Eventually, the car was found, along with the female occupant. Surprisingly, however, the woman was not forced into the vehicle. She then told law enforcement that she suspected her boyfriend, Billie Ray Ayala, 31-years-old, from Palataka, Fla., of making the phone call. The deputies called Ayala, who

arrest and transported him the Suwannee county Jail. He was charged with attempted burglary of an occupied conveyance assault. Upon booking Nunez into the County jail, it was revealed that he was deported from the United States to Mexico in 2020 and is currently listed as a deported felon. The Department of Homeland Security was contacted and an Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) detainee has been placed in charge of him.

claimed to be out of town and could not meet with the officers. At 1:30 a.m. on Saturday, May 7, another call was made to the SCSO. During this call, the male claimed a female had been injected with heroin and was unresponsive and not breathing. The male caller provided an address for the authorities to come to. However, when the 911 dispatcher attempted to provide CPR instructions, the caller hung up the phone. Many SCSO deputies and Suwannee County Fire Rescue emergency personnel attempted to respond to the address provided, only to find out the address provided did not exist. The 911 dispatchers continued to attempt to call and text the caller back, but received no response. Meanwhile, the on-ground authorities continued their search for the overdosed

victim. They came to an address numerically similar to the one provided by the caller. Inside was the same female from the abduction call a few hours earlier. The authorities then pinged the cell phone of the caller to determine his location. According to the cell service provider, the caller’s location was on County Road 136 West, only 15 miles away from where the authorities were searching. SCSO deputies made their way to the area only to discover Ayala, who had earlier claimed to be out of town. Ayala denied any knowledge of the multiple false 911 calls. The 911 dispatchers then called the number that had made the calls and Ayala’s phone rang. Seeing that he was caught, Ayala admitted to placing both calls. Ayala was then arrested and taken to the Suwannee County Jail. Ayala was charged with two counts of misuse of 911 and one count of providing false information to law enforcement.

# Suwannee Commissioners purchase two motor graders

On Tuesday, May 3, the Suwannee County Board of Commissioners met for their regularly scheduled meeting. The meeting began at 5 p.m. and was held at the Live Oak City Council building, located at 101 White Ave. SE, in Live Oak. In attendance were Don Hale, District 1; Clyde Fleming, District 2; Travis Land, District 3; Len Stapleton, District 4; Franklin White, District 5; County Administrator Randy Harris and County Attorney Jimmy Prevatt. The meeting began with a prayer, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. The board then made a small correction for the minutes of the previous meeting. They then approved the minutes. The board then moved to their consent agenda, where they pulled one item for discussion before approving the rest of the agenda. The board also approved Stapleton to serve on the Affordable Housing Advisory Committee.

The board then moved to hear their only time specific item, regard the CSX cell tower special permit request. Andy Rotenstreich, a representative for CSX, stood up to speak on behalf of CSX. Rotenstreich argued that CSX has accomplished all stipulations for the request and has come with answers to all of the questions the board had from the previous meeting. He then presented a map, showing the increase of

coverage that would happen due to the tower’s placement. He also presented photos, showing three examples of cell towers currently in Suwannee County that are closer than three quarters of a mile. Rotenstreich admitted it was unwise for them to involve AT&T in the request and wanted the board to remember this was a CSX tower on CSX property. He also presented proof that AT&T had contacted SBA, the tower AT&T is currently on, about their desire for a reduced rent. Ryan Maloney was next to speak in defense of SBA. Maloney argued that CSX hadn’t changed their initial application and all evidence presented was unsworn and wasn’t necessarily accurate. He continued to say that there is no reason CSX can’t use the SBA tower and warned the board that multiple towers will make the area ugly. Bo Hancock, a public citizen, stood up to argue in favor of CSX, saying its CSX’s property and they could do what they want. Moses Klepper stood up to argue in favor of a camouflaged pole, claiming that, despite what was said in the last meeting, according to his research, it was possible to camouflage the pole. The commissioners discussed the issue for a few moments before approving the special permit, allowing CSX to build the cell tower.

The board then began to discuss the possibility of exercising their purchase option on a property on 169<sup>th</sup> Road. Prevatt visited the site and presented the price of \$5,300 per acre to the

commissioners for a grand total of \$906,247 for the property. Prevatt was approved to use the purchase option and acquire the property for the county. The board then moved to speak on their motor graders. Land recommended to the board that they purchase two of the 140 motor graders. The rest of the commissioners agreed it would be wise to buy the two used 140s, so they then approved the purchase of the two used ones and a continued lease on the county’s other graders. The board also approved proceeds from surplus funds to be used to pay for it.

The board then began discussing the two offers they received on their surplus property, located on 112<sup>th</sup> Street. Both offers were well below the asking price, so the board rejected the offers and decided to readvertise the property at \$6,500 an acre. The board then approved Harris to modify and administer the agreement for the engineering and design of the new emergency operations center. Wayne Hannakah stood up during public comment to ask why the county had not officially banned the internet cafés yet. Prevatt openly took the blame, saying it was his fault for getting too busy, but as soon as he’s done with the draft it will be on the agenda. The meeting was then adjourned. The next Suwannee Board of County Commissioners will be held on Tuesday, May 24, starting at 5 p.m. The meeting will be held at the Judicial Annex, located at 218 W Parshley St., in Live Oak.

# Hamilton County changes EMS rates

On Tuesday, May 3, the Hamilton County Board of Commissioners met for their regularly scheduled meeting. The meeting began at 9 a.m. and was held at the Hamilton County Courthouse, located at 207 NE 1<sup>st</sup> St., in Jasper. In attendance were Jimmy Murphy, District 1; Josh Smith, District 2; Robert Brown, District 3; Randy Ogburn, District 4; Richie McCoy, District 5; Louie Goodin, County Coordinator and Interim Attorney Cliff Adams was present through speaker phone. The meeting began with a prayer, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

The first subject before the board was Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Director John Smith’s request for rate changes. Smith explained the last time that EMS had a rate change was four years ago. He explained that costs were going up for everyone and most counties were raising their rates slightly as well. Smith then recommended to the board that they adopt the average fee. The board unanimously adopted the rate changes. Next to speak was Spencer Nabors, giving an update on the grants the county was working on. Nabors told the board they are currently waiting on a septic permit for the SHIP grant. Nabors also requested that \$100,000 of the next SHIP payment be given to the Town of Jennings, due to the town needing help building a rehab center. The commissioners unanimously approved. The board then moved to hear from Thomas Howell and Ferguson who have been facilitating the American Rescue Plan. They announced that they had made it into the U.S. Treasury account and submitted their report to the Treasury early. They continued, saying they were still working on the doctor’s office. However, every current issue up to the date of the meeting had been solved. Smith then asked the representatives if they would feel comfortable not coming to every meeting. His reasoning was that they had a two hour drive, which is a long way just to give a few sentences of an update. The commissioners echoed this sentiment. They then reached a consensus and let the representatives have less attendance at the meetings, as long as there are no major updates. Adams then gave a small update on the local fuel tax option that he had been presenting to the municipalities. He let the commissioners know he had received the final approval from Jasper, making all the municipalities compliant with the tax. The commissioners then unanimously approved Jasper as the final induction. Next up was North Florida Professional Services (NFPS). Smith told NFPS that he doesn’t think the board should continue to pursue state funding for their grant. The rest of the board agreed and authorized Goodin to reject the state funding. They also discussed putting up weight limit signs on roads around the county that are being ruined by semi-trucks. There was also a small discussion about the beavers around the county blocking culverts and what the best solution was. The board then approved the repaving of Robin Road, as long as a pine tree that was dangerously close to falling was also taken care of.

The board then moved to award the bid for the new Jennings Bluff Campground restroom and shower building. There was only one bid from Plumb Construction for \$129,110. However, the county still needed power in the building. They then awarded the bid with the stipulation that they also find some way to get power into the building. The board then approved their consent agenda and their bill payments. The board also began discussion on the paint color of the new clinic. They were also made aware that there would be phase 1 redistricting at their next meeting. Smith then read a letter of appreciation from Suwannee County, saying thank you for all their help with the building department. The final action taken by the board was amending the rodeo budget to \$3,500. The meeting was then adjourned. The next Hamilton County Board of Commissioners meeting will be held on Tuesday, May 17, starting at 6 p.m. The meeting will be held at the Hamilton County Courthouse, located at 207 NE 1<sup>st</sup> St., in Jasper.

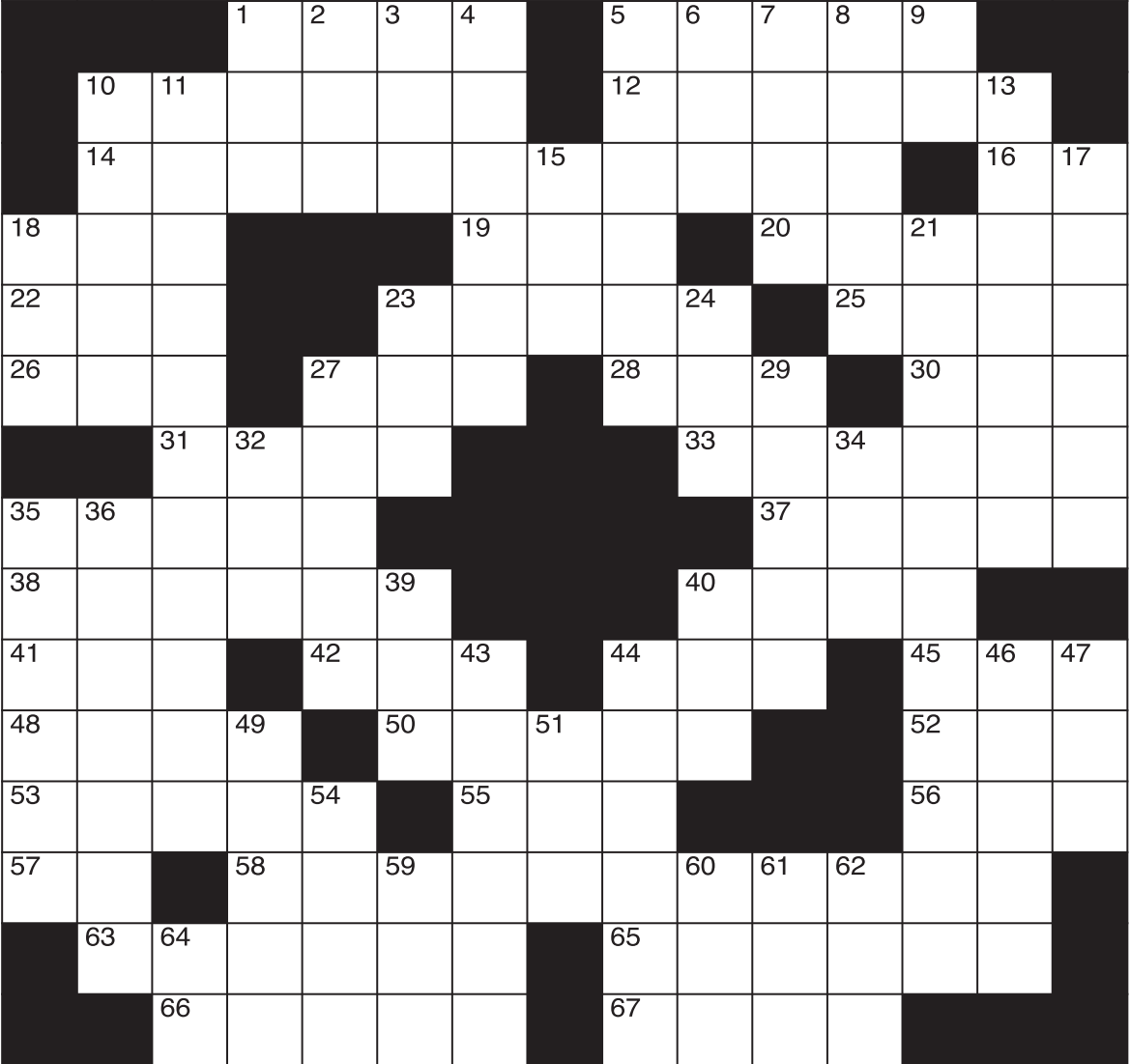
