Applicant: The applicant for this project is Suwannee American Cement Company, LLC. The applicant's responsible official and mailing address are: John Ralph, Plant Manager, Suwannee American Cement Company, LLC, 5117 US Highway 27, Branford, Florida 32008.

Facility Location: The applicant operates the existing Branford Cement Plant in Suwannee County at 5117 US Highway 27, Florida.

Project: The existing facility is a Portland cement plant incorporating a dry process kiln with a preheater and calciner. The facility includes a surface limestone mine. The manufacture of Portland cement primarily involves the crushing, grinding, and blending of limestone, clays, and other raw materials into a chemically proportioned mixture which is heated in a rotary kiln to extremely high temperature to produce clinker nodules. The clinker is cooled and ground with a small quantity of gypsum and other additives to produce finished cement.

Permit No. 1210465-063-AC clarifies that the Best Available Control Technology (BACT) limits for Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) are 0.15 pounds per ton (lb/ton) of clinker and 18.0 pounds per hour (lb/hr), as established in Permit No. 1210465-039-AC. However, Permit No. 1210465-060-AC, incorrectly cited a previous permit with limits of 0.12 lb/ton clinker and 14.4 lb/hr, which were replaced with the 0.15 lb/ton of clinker and 18.0 lb/hr, in Permit No. 1210465-060-AC. This permitting action merely rectifies the errors of Permit No. 1210465-060-AC. Since there is no material change to the facility, there are no emissions changes (increase or decrease) with the issuance of this draft permit.



Unless proper steps are initiated in a court of competent jurisdiction to secure relief within 20 days from the date of Board action at the above hearing (including the method of apportionment, the rate of assessment and the reimposition of assessments), such action shall be the final adjudication of the issues presented.
