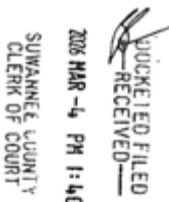

- The candidates who qualified for Town Council Seats 1, 3, and 5 each ran unopposed and are deemed elected without a ballot vote pursuant to Section 4.03 of the Town Charter. No council races appear on this ballot.

Town of White Springs — Proposed Charter Amendments

No. 1 Election of Councilmembers. That Sections 2.02(a) and 2.02(b) of the Town Charter be amended to confirm annual Town elections, two-year Council Member terms, and designated Council seats filled by plurality vote, with two seats filled in odd-numbered years and three seats in even-numbered years; to supersede the majority vote and runoff provisions of 2019 Amendment No. 1 while preserving and codifying its designated seat structure; and to void 2019 Amendments Nos. 4 and 5 in their entirety.

No. 2 Council Voting Requirements. That Section 2.05(a)(3) of the Town Charter be amended to provide that Town Council action requires an affirmative vote of a majority of the members present at a duly constituted quorum meeting, consistent with Florida Statute Section 166.041, while retaining all existing supermajority requirements specified elsewhere in the Charter.

No. 3 Ordinance Effective Date. That Section 2.07(c) of the Town Charter be amended to provide that adopted ordinances become effective ten (10) days after adoption, or as otherwise provided in the ordinance or by general law, consistent with Florida Statute Section 166.041(5), rather than immediately upon adoption as currently provided.

No. 4 Vacancy-in-Candidacy Procedure. That Section 4.03 of the Town Charter be amended to add procedures for a vacancy-in-candidacy after the close of qualifying, providing that a sole remaining candidate is automatically deemed elected, and that seats with no remaining candidates are filled by appointment or special election as required by law.

No. 5 Prohibition on Employment of Relatives. That Section 5.08 of the Town Charter be amended to replace the undefined term 'immediate family member' with the term 'relative' as defined in Section 112.3135, Florida Statutes, clarifying the scope of the prohibition on employment of Council Members' relatives.

No. 6 Suits Against the Town. That Section 10.04 of the Town Charter be amended to remove the existing pre-suit written notice requirement — which conflicts with Florida Statute Section 768.28 governing tort claims and is unenforceable as applied to contract claims — and replace it with a provision subjecting all claims against the Town to applicable general law while preserving all sovereign immunity defenses.
