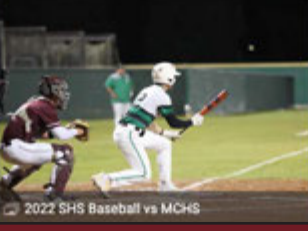
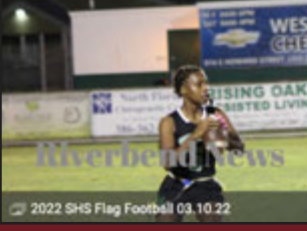

The Lafayette County Board of County Commissioners requests proposals from qualified individuals or firms to provide Administration Services for a Rebuild Florida FY 23/24 Storms Infrastructure Repair Program (IRP) award. The County has been awarded CDBG-DR funding in the amount of \$1,382,403.00 therefore procurement and contracting will follow CDBG regulations.

IRP Administration Services will include complete management of the project and all other federal- and state-imposed requirements for grant implementation and compliance.

Proposals will be considered on an equal competitive basis. Each response must be described separately and will be evaluated using the following criteria, which are listed in order of relative importance.

- (1) Knowledge and Experience with the Florida Small Cities CDBG Programs - 25 points
- (2) Qualifications of Staff Working Directly on CDBG Project - 25 points
- (3) Approach to Meeting Project Needs, including Task Outline - 25 points
- (4) Familiarity or Ability to Quickly Become Familiar with Local Conditions - 20 points
- (5) Fee - 5 points
- (6) MBE/WBE Certified Firm – 1 point

Proposals for IRP Administration Services must indicate a fee for the service, with an explanation of the basis for the fee. Fee may be quoted as lump sum, percentage or hourly rate. A Public Entity Crimes Statement must be submitted with proposal responses to the RFP. Certified MBE/WBE firms are encouraged to submit certification documents with their proposals.

The deadline to submit questions is July 17, 2026 at 5:00 P.M. Questions shall be submitted in writing to Steve Land, Clerk of Court, at sland@lafayetteclerk.com.

An original and two (2) copies of sealed proposals, marked "IRP Administration Services" must be received by July 24, 2026 at 12:00 P.M., at the Lafayette County Clerk of Court's Office, 120 W Main Street, Mayo, FL 32066. Proposals will be opened as soon as possible after the submission deadline. A Ranking Committee will evaluate and rank proposals in accordance with CDBG requirements. The City Council will make the final selection.

The IRP Administration Services contract is subject to grant award and release of funds by the funding agency.
